At DPS Gurgaon, we have always believed in embracing change with enthusiasm and readiness and challenges created by COVID-19 were no exception. As a Microsoft Showcase Incubator School, we reviewed all available options for teacher development and finalized the UN-ICT Framework based Microsoft Certified Educator (MCE) certification program. The goal was to bring transformational change in online education experience in addition to supplementing regular class-room based pedagogy. In a world where the role of technology has become predominant, the MCE program seemed like the best choice which trains teachers and enables them with the knowledge needed to integrate 21st century skills in their teaching practices. We used MCE program to equip teachers with ICT competency to design enhanced learning experiences and facilitate a hybrid learning environment for our students to maximise learning outcomes.
